BIO: A Chattanooga native, Wes Hodges led the 2003 Baylor School team to their first ever state championship and also the Chattanooga Cyclones to a fall team record for wins. His senior year at Baylor Wes was drafted by the Chicago White Sox in the 13th round but elected to attend Georgia Tech instead. He helped lead Tech to Super Regional play 2004, 2005 & 2006, and to the College World Series in 2006.

Baseball America Ranked him as the #4 freshman in the nation upon entering Georgia Tech and in his Sophomore year ranked him 20th when he finished his season 4th in school history (tied with Jason Varitek) in hits (106) with a .397 batting average. He played Team USA in the summer of '05. As a junior, Wes was a preseason All-American and was drafted by the Cleveland Indians in the 2nd round. Wes was named to the 2007 Carolina League ALL-STAR team and was named 5th best prospect and best power hitting prospect in the Carolina league. In 2008 Wes named Rookie of the Year in AA Eastern League, and played in the prestigious Futures All-Star game and AFC Top Prospects game. In 2009 Wes played in AAA.
